PURPOSE

The purpose of the Blount County Housing Repair Collaborative (HRC) is to provide home repairs and household rehabilitation for low-income families in Blount County by

- Coordinating the work of local and out-of-town volunteer crews from churches, civic clubs, businesses, and non profits.
- Assisting volunteer crews in identifying resources to fund projects.
- Providing a consistent means of assessing, planning, and evaluating projects.

HRC HISTORY

In the fall of 2007, the HRC was initiated by United Way of Blount County and facilitated by Dr. Billy Newton of the Center for Strong Communities at Maryville College. Since its creation, and with the financial and volunteer support of dozens of community groups, the HRC has completed over 100 projects in Blount County, provided more than 700 volunteers with nearly 20,000 hours of work, and, most importantly, improved the housing situations and lives of nearly a thousand individuals in Blount County.
